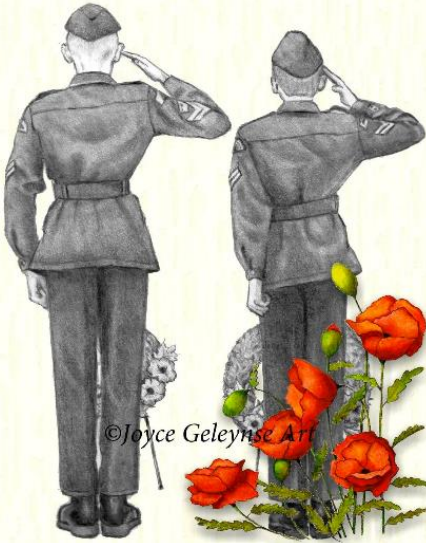
In Flanders Fields

Inclusive Playground Updates

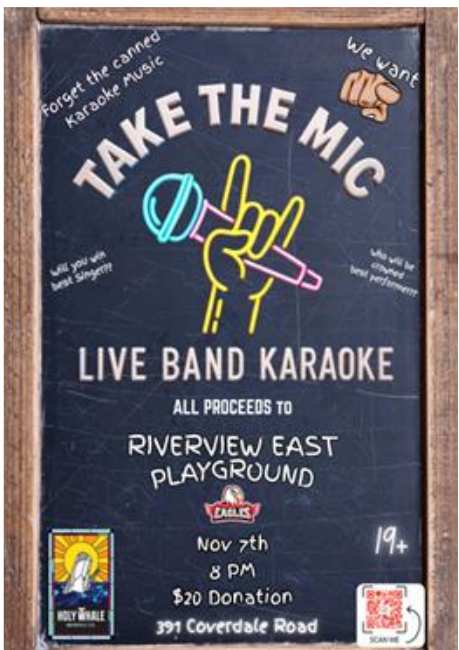
