- Presentation from Riverview East SPR team (School Improvement Plan 2025-2026): SPR team-Manon: Literacy good interaction in ELA and French. Data presented. ORF data presented. Reading well but slowly can influence comprehension. Improvement Idea-data will influence instruction. Monitoring Plan-presented-focus on phonics. Data wall added to and available. Interventions are monitored. Baseline presented. Using EGLA to see where exactly students are struggling. Robin Smith is in to focus on k-2 interventions. SPR team-Numeracy-Becky-in 3 math strands ahead of district average. New curriculum. Focus will be on number strand. Data collected for grade 3, 4, and 5. Holistic math curriculum is not in place that will be a focus of quantity and place value. It was not taught before in the prioritized curriculum. Progress will be tracked through district-based excel doc. Data will help to guide interventions. Instruction will be differentiated for students individually with Holistic teaching. Action plan for Math-support for math from district and monthly meetings for Math. SPR team-Safety, Caring, and Engagement-AJ-students are able to express themselves for schoolwork. Data suggests that students are feeling safer compared to 3 years ago. Lower scores in feedback. The plan-collect data and offer support. SPR and team meetings. Data to support another SPR-advocating for more time for teachers to plan and prepare.
