TEACHING, COACHING & REDIRECTION

- Reminders & coaching
- Guided Strategies
- Routines & norms clearly established & reinforced

- Connect with families
- Address concerns
- Collaborate for success
- Wrap around supports



REFLECTION & ADMIN / BIM SUPPORT

- Reflection Hall w/Admin & BIM to revisit expectations and next steps
- Response when clear boundaries are crossed



INTENSIVE SUPPORTS

Ongoing or safety concerns may require family meetings, behaviour plans & targeted interventions. When necessary, suspensions or assignments home. *What does a safe and successful return to learning look like?*
